

Merseyside County Award for meritorious Services to Athletics

Criteria for the award

The award is open to all volunteers involved in athletics in Merseyside in recognition of an outstanding contribution to the sport at club, county or schools level over a period of at least 15 years; or to mark a special achievement. The winner is likely to have made a significant contribution week in, week out, for the love of the sport and shown a commitment to personal development, teamwork and supporting the development of athletes, others involved in athletics or the sport itself.

No person may receive the award more than once.

Who can nominate

Any person or club or association based in Merseyside can make a nomination.

The nomination must be as full as possible, detailing the length of service, the nature and extent of the involvement in athletics, any significant achievements and an indication of the beneficial impact the nominee has made in the sport within Merseyside.

Who will decide the winner

Each nomination must be made in writing to the Secretary of Merseyside County Athletic Association by the end of February each year. All nominations will be considered by a Panel set up by Merseyside County AA and the winner will be announced at the county AGM in April.

The Panel's decision shall be final and they will not enter into any correspondence with the nominator except to clarify a point or seek further information.
